Description:

This missionary staff position is an exciting opportunity to live and work in Gulu, Uganda and design and lead Zion Project's outreach programs of preaching, discipleship, praying for the sick, and Kingdom advancement into the community. Our desire is to reach more people with the gospel of love and draw more women out of the sex-industry to transform communities. Will be supervised by Country Director.

About Zion Project:

Zion Project is a faith-based 501c3 (NGO) operating in the war-torn region of northern Uganda (Gulu) offering God's love, healing counseling, and empowerment through alternative employment to women and formerly abducted girls caught in the sex-industry. We also operate a girl's Rescue Home for children who are sexually exploited. Our vision is to see transformation through God's love as we bring heaven to earth and teach Kingdom principles to raise up leaders and launch destinies.

Overall Program Details

All Uganda-based positions are full time. Time commitment is 1-2 years depending on availability. A commitment to a 40-50 hour work week.

Guest home housing will be provided.

We encourage all missionaries to fundraise for this position both prior to and during their time in Uganda. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.

Position begins ideally ASAP. Applications due June 1, 2012
